Think First of Greater Kansas City

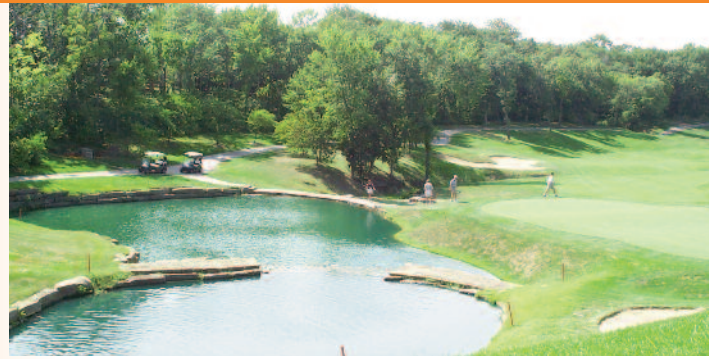
Think First of Greater Kansas City is part of a national, award-winning injury prevention program that teaches youth to "use their mind to protect their body". Established in 1987, the organization provides free school-based presentations for grades K-12 throughout Greater Kansas City, reaching approximately 30,000 youth each year. The program is delivered by speakers who have sustained a brain injury or spinal cord injury through one of four preventable situations. They give young people valuable information about seat belt safety, helmet use, avoiding diving injuries by checking with your "feet first" and avoiding guns and violence. The Kansas City chapter serves Clay, Platte, Jackson and Cass Counties in Missouri and Johnson and Wyandotte counties in Kansas.

Motor vehicle crashes are the number one cause of death for children ages 4 to 14. Two out of five deaths among teens in the U.S. are the result of motor-vehicle crashes. Think First seeks to change these devastating statistics through education and advocacy.

Traumatic Injury Statistics:

- Seat belts: 97.2% of drivers involved in crashes that were not killed or injured were wearing their seatbelt.
- Helmet use: Non helmeted riders are 14 times more likely to be involved in a fatal crash than helmeted riders. Helmets can prevent an estimated 75% of bicycle fatalities among children.
- Diving: 90% of diving injuries result in quadriplegia
- Guns: Everyday in the United States, approximately nine children under age 19 are killed by guns.
